THE VISION

To provide real-world interdisciplinary, personalized, and project-based learning experiences through a STEAM-based academic program where graduates become the next generation of leaders, employers, and employees who contribute to the economic well-being of their communities and families.

FUNDING THE GAP

\$2,064

Receiving only roughly 70% of scholar funding from state and federal departments, none of which comes from local property tax, **our deficit amounts to \$2,064 per scholar**.

\$2MM+

The fundraising need for school year 2025-2026 amounts to over \$2MM.

\$40MM

With no government funding for transportation or facilities, LSC will need to raise approximately \$40MM to build out our future academies in the next five to seven years.
